As a CCMS athlete, our young people have an image to reflect: one of positive leadership, character, responsibility, competitive spirit and integrity. It is imperative that all spectators uphold the same dignity and respect. The Administration and/or Athletic Director have the right to remove an individual from an athletic event if the Spectator fails to abide by the following expectations:

- To emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- To eliminate all possibilities which tend to destroy the best values of the game.
- To stress the values derived from playing the game fairly.
- To demonstrate courtesy to visiting teams and officials.
- To establish a positive relationship between visitors and hosts.
- To respect the integrity and judgment of the sports officials.
- To achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules of the fame and standards of eligibility.
- To encourage leadership, use of incentive and good judgment by the players on the team.
- To recognize that the purpose of athletics is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social and emotional well-being of the individual players.
- To remember that an athletic contest is only a game ... not a matter of life or death for player, coach, school, official, fan, community, state or nation.
