Key Dates

- Offseason training every T/W/Th from April 13th to June 22nd
- KHSAA Dead Period June 25th – July 9th
- Mandatory beginning July 10th
- Tryouts: July 12th – 14th
- Rosters announced July 15th
- Camp Camel: July 17th – 20th
- Season begins August 15th
- Second Tryout August 19th
- Postseason begins October 9th

Tryouts

- Must be a CCS 7th grader or above in the fall of 2017 to tryout
- Player must have a current physical on file - valid for 12 months
- Player evaluations will be in large part based on fitness level, technical ability (juggling, passing, dribbling, etc.) and overall understanding of the game
- Fitness expectations include
 - o 2 mile timed run (\leq 13 minutes for Varsity, \leq 16 ½ minutes non-Varsity)
 - o 3x400m with brief rest period (\leq 1 ½ minutes each lap for Varsity, \leq 2 minutes for non-Varsity)

Practices

- Captain led warm-up to begin 15 minutes prior to the start of practice
- All players expected to be dressed and warmed up by the start of practice
- Player to bring their own ball, shin guards, gym shoes, and water bottle to each practice

- Soccer socks must be worn. No tube socks, ankle socks, etc.
- Practices will be held at the stadium field unless communicated otherwise
- Once school starts, the goal is to shorten practices from 2 hours to 1 ½ hours

Attendance

- Mandatory attendance starting July 10th
- All preseason conflicts must be communicated to Coach Newman no later than July 16th
- All in-season conflicts must be communicated to Coach Newman no less than a week ahead of time
- Excused absences include
 - o family emergency
 - o player is sick (with note)
 - o conflicts with other school/extracurricular activities that are communicated in the before mentioned timeframe
 - o club soccer (7th and 8th graders)
- Unexcused absences will result in a suspension of one half of play in the following game (carry over does apply)
